# Rhinebeck Jamboree 2018

#### MID-HUDSON RADIO CONTROL SOCIETY, INC. Dutchess County, NY

#### Featuring: 200' wide by 2000' long grass runway Six Flight Stations

#### **Overall Requirements:**

- 1) Aircraft must be Scale models of aircraft built prior to December 31, 1939.
- 2) Models of aircraft used in WWII combat situations are NOT eligible.
- 3) All AMA rules and regulations apply unless otherwise noted.
- 4) Maximum model weight is 55 pounds.
- 5) All participants will be required to show an AMA membership card.
- 6) Participants must follow all FAA regulations.
- 7) Only ONE frequency pin per individual will be permitted on the Flight Line at any given time.

#### SAFETY:

- 1) All Pilots must sign an AMA Safety Declaration prior to the first flight. If repairs are made on the field, the model must be fully safety inspected by the Field Safety Marshal prior to any further flight activity.
- 2) Pilot <u>MUST</u> be accompanied by an observer/spotter.
- 3) All aircraft must have been successfully flown prior to the Jamboree.

#### LANDING FEE:

A landing fee of \$35 will be charged to each event entrant & one helper which includes a three day pass to all Aerodrome Museums and shows. Additional quests must purchase passes from the Aerodrome admission booth.

#### **MISSION EVENT FEE:**

There is an additional \$10 fee for pilots flying the Mission event

#### **COLE PALEN MEMORIAL AWARDS:**

- Spirit of Rhinebeck (all aircraft eligible, flight not required)
- Best of Show (one flight required)
- Best Civilian (one flight required)
- Best WW1
  (one flight required)
- Best Golden Age
  (one flight required)
- Best of Show Junior Pilot (one flight required, under 18)
- Mission event awards to 3rd place.

Note: Winning aircraft may only qualify for awards for a maximum of two years.

- Saturday and Sunday 8:00 AM "Cole Palen Memorial" *mass rubber powered scale aircraft Launch*.
- Saturday 6:00 PM ORA Dinner/Fundraiser. *Dinner tickets available at the weekend or call ahead to the ORA office*.
- Saturday and Sunday 2:30 PM *Full scale Air show* featuring the original and replica aircraft of the Old Rhinebeck Aerodrome. *Biplane rides available after the air shows.*
