- Warren Batson brought in his 1/4 scale Fokker D7, Balsa USA work in progress project. It has a wingspan of 84", powered by a Zenoah G38 gas engine. Target weight is 23-25 pounds.
- Bob Allen brought his electric powered Fokker D7, Great Planes model. Powered by a 400 motor and 3 cell Lypo battery pack. A real easy kit to put together.
- Whitney presented the new budget proposal to the club members present. A motion was made by Rick Rizza to accept the proposed budget, seconded by John Philbrick. The voting passed with the results of 31 "yes" and 0 "no".
