- Warren Batson discussed the cancellation of the merger between the MHRCS and SOURS clubs.
- There was a discussion on the incoming process for potential new members. Lou Callen made a motion for the Board to revisit the By-Laws. The motion was second by Dave Simons. All voted in favor, with no one against.
- Warren mentioned that there is a moratorium on turbine jet flying at the club fields. The Board will be looking into pros and cons of turbine flying.
