- Warren noted that the Wallkill Field and entrance is soft due to the recent amounts of rain. Also, the flight stations at the field are being stowed “on end” to prevent the crows from messing up the surfaces when not in use.

 - The current status of the Saturday banquet is “iffy” due to the high cost to have it catered.
